

Zippy Triangle Shawl

It's a breeze to knit with its large open stitches; it provides a lovely evening shoulder cover up.



Knitting Loom:
(5) Zippy Looms,
20 pegs total

Yarn:
Approximately
80 yards of
super bulky
yarn. Sample
used Loops &
Threads Opus,
2 skeins in
Bermuda color.
42 yds each

Stitches: Knit
and Purl

Notions:
Knitting tool, big
eye tapestry
needle

Size: Top of
triangle 50"
point to point.
Top to center
back is 20"

Gauge: 5 sts x 9
rows= 4 inches
using the Knit
Stitch/U Stitch



Instructions

Ewrap cast on (from left to right) 2 stitches in center of loom.

Row 1: k to end of row.

Row 2: Increase one at the beginning of the row, purl to the end of row.

Rep Row 1 and Row 2 until you have increased to 20 stitches.

Next row: knit to the end of row

Next row: purl to the end of row.

Next row: knit to the end of row.

Next row: Decrease one at the beginning of the row, purl to the end of row.

Repeat from ** to ** until you have 2 stitches remaining.

Bind off loosely with basic bind off method.

Weave all ends in. Block to open up the stitches.
