

Men's Cowl Infinity Scarf



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"Diamonds in the Ruff"

This super cozy cowl is for the man in your life. It is a super fast knit and makes a great last minute gift. This project is great for travel or social knitting. It is also a great project for using that lonely skein. What do I love most about it? It's reversible; so it looks great when worn twisted around the neck.

Finished size after blocking is approximately 7 wide and 24 long when folded. This scarf will wrap twice around the neck.

Gauge : 5 sts per inch in Stockinette St.

Materials:

- US Size 7 circular needle
- 1 stitch markers (optional)
- 1 skein worsted weight yarn
- For this sample I used Patons Classic Worsted Yarn

Abbreviations:

St= Stitch

K= Knit

P = Purl

PM= Place Marker

BO= Bind Off

CO = Cast On

Directions:

CO 198, PM, begin to knit in the round in a K1, P1 ribbing. Be careful not to twist stitches.

Continue in a K1, P1 ribbing for a total of 12 rows. Then start the pattern.

The Pattern

This pattern is knit in multiples of 9. (Please keep this in mind if you wish to shorten or lengthen the pattern.)

Row 1 (RS): k4, *p1, k8; rep from * to last 5 sts, p1, k4

Row 2: K3, *p3,k6, rep from * to last 6 sts, p3,k3

Row 3: k2, *p5, k4; rep from * to last 7 sts, p5, k2

Row 4 K1, *p7,k2, rep from* to the last 8 sts, p7, k1

Row 5: P

Row 6: Rep Row 4

Row 7: Rep Row 3

Row 8: Rep Row 2

Repeat this pattern (rows 1 – 8) one more time. End by finishing it with Row 1. (That's 3repeats of row 1 in total. Two repeats of the pattern.)

Continue on in a K1, P1 ribbing pattern for 11 rows then BO off loosely in pattern.

Block and weave in ends.
