

# Reversible cable scarf

I made this scarf a few years ago.

Yarn: Cleckheaton Angora Supreme

Needles: Not 100% sure but I believe I used 5.5mm. Tension is not vital, I would recommend that if you are a 'standard' knitter you use 1 size bigger than the size stated on the yarn ball band. Of course if you are a tight or loose knitter adjust the size to suit.

C8B – put next 4 stitches on to cable needle and hold at back of work, (k1 p1) twice then (k1 p1) twice from cable needle.

Pattern:

Cast on 40 stitches (12 stitch repeat +4)

Row 1 & 2 K2 P2 \*(K1 P1) 4 times k2 p2 . Repeat from \* 2 times

Row 3 & 4 P2 K2 \*(K1 P1) 4 times P2 K2 . Repeat from \* 2 times.

Row 5 & 6: K2 P2 \*(K1 P1) 4 times k2 p2 . Repeat from \* 2 times

Row 7: P2 K2 \*C8B P2 K2. Repeat from \* 2 times.

Row 8: P2 K2 \*(K1 P1) 4 times P2 K2 Repeat from \* 2 times.

Repeat pattern until desired length is reached finishing with row 6.

Cast off in pattern.

Updated 26/3/09 as pattern contained extra stitches between the cables. Pattern now matches picture.



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**Note for Left Handed knitters:** Your cables will cross in the other direction, this is not a problem however if you do want them to cross as in the picture then substitute the C8B with C8F.



C8F – put next 4 stitches on to cable needle and hold at front of work, (k1 p1) twice then (k1 p1) twice from cable needle.

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
