

# Le Poncho d'Alexis



This poncho is a co-creation of Clémence and Elisabeth. It was realized with three different techniques :1x1 Rib Stitch, Seed Stitch and Cable stitch.

## 1 x 1 Rib Stitch

Row 1: \*K1, p1,\* rep from \* to end.

## Seed stitch (seed sts)

Row 1: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

## Cable Stitch

Begin by purling 4 stitches, then slip the next 3 sts onto a cable needle.

Let the cable needle with the stitches to the front of your work.

Purl the next 3 stitches.

Knit this 3 sts off the cable needle.

Purl the last 4 stitches.

Continue the following row simply knit the knit and purl the purls.

## Instructions :

The Poncho is knitted with Partner 6 (Phildar), a french wool, approximatively 10 / 15 wool balls (50g each, 66 meters).

The poncho is based on 2 rectangles of the same dimensions and 1 collar.

Needles size 6 mm

## First rectangle

Cast on 72 sts.

1th rnd, 3th rnd, 5th rnd : : K1, p1, K1, p1, K1, 4p, 6K, 4p, 53 seed sts

2th rnd, 4th rnd, 6th rnd : 53 seed sts – 4K, 6p, 4K – 5 last sts as they are (knit the knit and purl the purls).

7th rnd : 5 first sts as they are (knit the knit and purl the purls) / 14 cable stitch /53 seed sts

Repeat always from the 2nd rnd and redo 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 rnds.

Continue like this until piece measures 70 cm and cast off.

## Second rectangle

Cast on 72 sts.

1th rnd, 3th rnd, 5th rnd : 53 seed sts – 4P, 6k, 4P, 1K, 1p, 1K, 1p, 1K

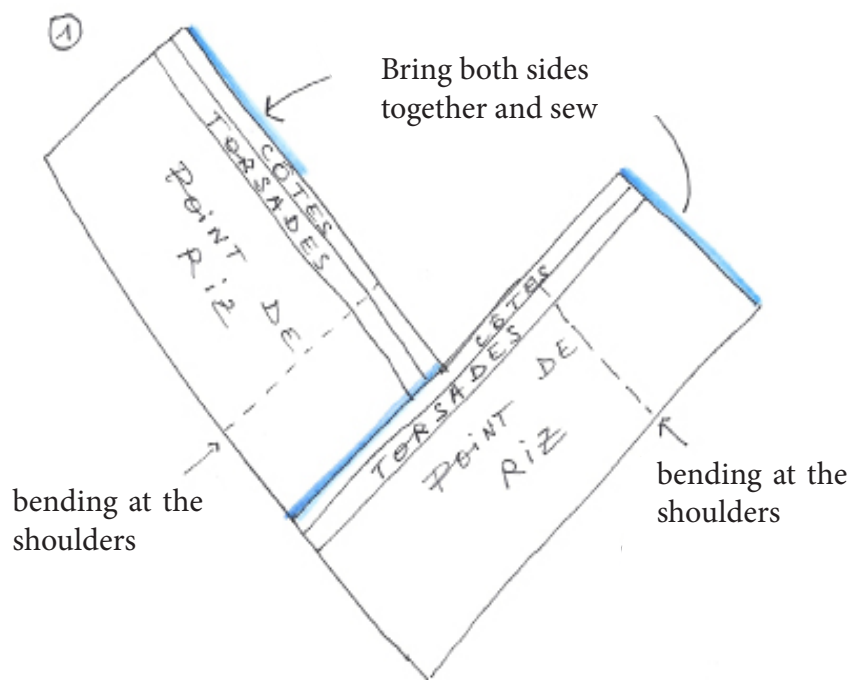
2th rnd, 4th rnd, 6th rnd : 5 first sts as they are (knit the knit and purl the purls) - 4K, 6p, 4K – 53 seed stitch

7th rnd : 53 seed stitch / 14 cable stitch / 5 last sts as they are (knit the knit and purl the purls).

Repeat always from the 2nd rnd and redo 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 rnds.

Continue like this until piece measures 70 cm and cast off.

## Assembly



## Collar :

Cast on 15 sts.

1th rnd and all following odd rows.

1K, 1p, 1K, 1p, 1K, 10 seed sts.

2th rnd and all following even rows

10 seed sts – 5 last sts as they are (knit the knit and purl the purls).

When the collar measures as the neckline, cast off.

Sew collar to neckline.
