

KNIT A WOOL TURBAN TAPE

Today is Wednesday, and Wednesdays on **Tutéate** ... we share a new **DIY video tutorial** ! Today we show how to weave a **turban tape** or **wool earmuff headband** with a **loom** , an **easy and fast** project with which to protect our head from the cold in an original way. What do you think!

Used materials:

- Loom with more than 11 posts with crochet hook and wool needle -> [[You can buy these looms here](#)]
- 75g (approx.) Thick wool Katia ARTICO for needles 10 - 12
- Thread or cord (we use it in a moment of the tutorial, but it does not stay on the tape)
- Tape measure and scissors



Steps to follow:

Start: Assemble 11 loom posts.

First part: knit rows of 1 stitch right - 1 stitch up to 17cm long.

Central part: place the loop of the central post on the next post and first knit a half (5 posts) following in 1 right stitch - 1 reverse stitch until it has a length of 10cm. Then weave the other half until it is also 10cm long. Use the auxiliary thread or cord to cross one strip with the other.



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Second part: knit whole rows again of 1 right stitch - 1 back stitch until this part also measures 17cm.

Final: Place the first row again on the loom and join it to the last to close.
